The Grosse Pointe Art Center wants you to be a part of our Fundraiser Auction, **CALL AND RESPONSE**, September 27th, 2009.

The first **100 pieces** submitted starting **June 2th 2009** will be the source of inspiration for a professional artist! The professional art-partner will select a child's piece and respond by creating a new work for our auction. The art-partner will not be putting your piece in their work, just using it for a jumping-off point.

You and your artist-partner will exhibit both pieces next to each other at the auction. The professional artist will be donating their art to the fundraiser and you may choose to have your artwork returned to you at the end of the fundraiser or to donate it for the auction too.

Choose your favorite piece of art or make a new one. Only 1 piece per child please. All media (painting, sculpture, printing, tiles, masks, etc) will be accepted, but you have to hurry; only the first 100 pieces will be eligible. All children Grades K-5 are invited.

Submission starts Tuesday, June 2nd and runs through Saturday, June 6th, 2009 at the Grosse Pointe Art Center, 16900 Kercheval Ave, Grosse Pointe, in the village. We are located in the former Village Toy Store. Call 821-1848 for additional information.

Work must have been done in the last two years. All art forms are acceptable. A diptych or triptych will be considered as one piece, if attached. No size limitations. Physical take-in required. First come first served, only the first 100 will be accepted.

Entry Procedure and Sales [Check calendar for specific dates]

There is no entry fee for children submitting. Entry form and parent or guardian signature required.

Works requested to be returned are picked up the week after the show at the Art Center. Donations with commission (20%) will be paid after the exhibit.
